She worked tirelessly to open this very first dental center dedicated to serving children with Medical Assistance in 2005. As a result of her vision and dedication, this center provides quality oral health care for over 4,000 children annually. She is remembered as a person who cared deeply for the poor and was a strong voice and advocate where there was none.
