Whereas: All Maryland residents quit the use of all tobacco products and limit alcoholic

drinks; and

Whereas: Use a lip balm with SPF of at least 15 anytime outdoors and consume a diet rich in

fruits and vegetables; and

Whereas: Vaccinate boys and girls beginning at age 11 or 12 against the Human

Papillomavirus (HPV), the risk of Oral Cancer can be reduced; and

Whereas: The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene Office of Oral Health supports the

early detection of oral cancer and prevention of the disease through yearly oral cancer screenings and promoting tobacco cessation programs, such as, the

Maryland Tobacco Quitline, 1-800-QUIT-NOW.
