# **Maryland Oral Health Resource Guide 2026 Edition**

The Maryland Oral Health Resource Guide is produced by the Maryland Department of Health Office of Oral Health, to assist families, caregivers and advocates in finding affordable public health dental care services in Maryland and in the immediate surrounding regions.

Only those dental public health programs or facilities which provide reduced, low-cost, and/or special needs dental services are listed in this directory. There is no intent to advertise, endorse, or promote any particular dental provider, program, or service. Information about other resources including the Maryland Healthy Smiles Program and programs in nearby Delaware and Washington, D.C. is also listed.

The services listed in this guide are organized by county. Marylanders have access to dental public health services whether they are available within the county or through standing arrangements or policies whereby programs will treat patients from outside their respective city, county, or regional limits. It is important to review the eligibility requirements and clinical services provided for each program before scheduling an appointment. For example, if a program lists a sliding fee scale payment option, ask what personal information is needed in order to receive the reduced fees. Programs listed often use different terms to describe services, eligibility, insurance coverage, and other topics; please refer to the expanded definitions section, beginning on p. 67, for more information.

We update this dental resource guide annually, but programs, contact information, services, and eligibility requirements may change over time. If you have any questions about the information listed, please contact the Office of Oral Health at 410-767-7915.

We trust that the Maryland Oral Health Resource Guide will be of assistance in finding the appropriate dental care that you, your family, or client needs.

## Definitions

<b>Acute care</b>	Necessary treatment that occurs over a short period of time for an emergency, urgent care dental problem; often associated with pain.
<b>Assessment</b>	An evaluation of the dental health status of an individual by performing a dental examination or screening after obtaining a medical and dental health history.
<b>Bedbound</b>	Those confined to or unable to get out of bed without assistance.
<b>Bleaching (dental)</b>	Tooth whitening services.
<b>Case management</b>	Coordination of services to help meet a patient's health care needs including assisting persons to obtain and coordinate community resources.
<b>Cleft lip and/or palate</b>	Genetic abnormality (present at birth) that causes an opening in the upper lip and/or the hard and soft palate of the mouth.
<b>Community Health Center (CHC)</b>	Private, non-profit health centers usually supported by government funds that are community-based and patient-directed organizations that serve populations with limited access to health care. Also known as Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC), Maryland Qualified Health Centers (MQHC), or other private, non-profit programs.
<b>Community outreach services</b>	Activities conducted by individuals in a dental program to connect its ideas or practices to the efforts of other organizations, groups, specific audiences, or the general public.
<b>Comprehensive dental services</b>	Dental services including prevention, periodontal, restorative, endodontic, and oral surgery.

<b>Craniofacial anomalies</b>	Atypical conditions of the head and face, especially as a result of hereditary or congenital defects. Also called orofacial anomalies.
<b>Dental (oral) hygiene</b>	The practice of keeping the mouth and teeth clean to prevent dental problems, usually in the form of dental cleanings, fluoride treatments, and other prevention services.
<b>Dental cleaning</b>	Part of dental (oral) hygiene and involves the removal of dental plaque from teeth with the intention of preventing tooth decay, gingivitis, and periodontal disease. Can include the removal of tartar below the gum surface.
<b>Dental sealants</b>	A dental prevention service consisting of applying a plastic material to one tooth or more, for the intended purpose of preventing tooth decay.
<b>Emergency services</b>	Urgent care; pain relief for acute care needs. Often for unscheduled, walk-in patients.
<b>Endodontics</b>	Root canal treatment.
<b>Extractions</b>	Pulling a tooth or teeth. Simple extractions are often non-surgical and indicated usually for single-rooted teeth; also referred to as Oral Surgery.
<b>Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC)</b>	A comprehensive primary care provider that offers care to all persons regardless of their ability to pay and is governed by a consumer dominated board of directors. Also known as a Community Health Center.
<b>Fee-for-service</b>	Where dental services are paid for separately either directly or through dental insurance.

<b>Fluoride</b>	A naturally occurring element found in rocks, soil, fresh water, and ocean water. Based on scientific research, fluoride is added to toothpaste and drinking water to prevent tooth decay, strengthen tooth enamel, and kill germs that cause tooth decay.
<b>Fluoride treatment</b>	The delivery of fluoride to the teeth, usually in the form of toothpaste, gel, varnish, or mouth rinse in order to prevent tooth decay. Usually part of dental (oral) hygiene or prevention services.
<b>General dentistry</b>	Dental services including dental hygiene, preventive, restorative, and simple oral surgery.
<b>Grey area</b>	Those not eligible for Medicaid and without private insurance.
<b>HealthChoice</b>	A component of Medicaid or the Maryland Medical Assistance Program (MA), it is Maryland's statewide mandatory managed care program which provides health care to most Medicaid recipients. Eligible Medicaid recipients enroll in a Managed Care Organization (MCO) of their choice. Children's dental services are generally not part of this program but offered instead through the Maryland Healthy Smiles Program. Limited dental benefits for adults may be available through one of the MCOs; please contact the program at 1-410-767-8500 for more information.
<b>Homebound</b>	Those confined to or unable to leave home without assistance.

<b>Homeless</b>	The Health Center Program authorizing statute (section 330(h)(5)) defines a homeless individual as an individual who lacks housing (without regard to whether the individual is a member of a family), including an individual whose primary residence during the night is a supervised public or private facility that provides temporary living accommodations and an individual who is a resident in transitional housing.
<b>Managed Care Organizations (MCOs)</b>	Maryland Medicaid or Maryland Medical Assistance Program (MA) health insurance companies that are part of the Maryland HealthChoice Program. Please contact the HealthChoice Program at 1-410-767-5800 for more information about an MCO.
<b>Maryland Healthy Smiles Dental Program (Medicaid)</b>	The Maryland Medicaid dental program also known as the dental program for Medicaid Assistance (MA, Maryland Medicaid Program, and Maryland Medical Assistance Program.)
<b>Maryland Medical Assistance Program (Medicaid)</b>	Government health insurance program for income eligible children and adults. Also known in Maryland for the dental program as Medical Assistance (MA, Maryland Medicaid Program, and Maryland Healthy Smiles Dental Program.)
<b>Maryland Primary Adult Care Program (PAC)</b>	A health coverage program for low-income adults age 19 and over who do not qualify for other Medical Assistance (Medicaid) programs. Limited dental services may be available through one of the Medicaid Health Choice Managed Care Organizations (MCOs). Call 1-800-226-2142 or go online to: <a href="http://mmcp.health.maryland.gov">mmcp.health.maryland.gov</a> for more details.
<b>Maryland Qualified Health Center (MQHC)</b>	A non-profit health center that provides the same scope of services as a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) and offers discounted fees to the low income and uninsured. Also known as a Community Health Center.

**Maryland Tobacco Quitline** 1-800-QUIT-NOW, provides FREE evidenced-based tobacco use cessation counseling, in English and Spanish, to assist Marylanders ages 13 and older with quitting tobacco use. Quit Coaches are available 24 hours a day, seven days per week, including those who are specially trained to assist pregnant callers through their quitting process. Callers who are 18 years of age and older also have free access to the new Web Coach and Text2Quit services. Web Coach is an interactive online cessation tool that can be paired with phone and text services. Text2Quit includes tailored text messages sent to the caller's mobile device. 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**Medicaid** Government health insurance program for income eligible children and adults. Also known in Maryland for the dental program known as Medical Assistance (MA, Maryland Medical Assistance Program, Maryland Medicaid Program, and Maryland Healthy Smiles Dental Program.)

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**Medically compromised** Health conditions that require special attention when receiving dental or surgical services.

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**Non-surgical extraction** Also known as a simple extraction. Refers to the extraction of a single-rooted teeth.

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**Offsite** Dental services provided outside the dental program facility in a community program such as in a school, Head Start or long-term care facility. Please call program for specific details.

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**Onsite** Dental services provided directly in the dental program facility.

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<b>Oral and maxillofacial surgery</b>	Complex surgical procedures involving the mouth, head and neck regions.
<b>Oral cancer</b>	A cancer that develops in the tissues of the mouth or throat. One of the biggest risk factors is tobacco use - including smoking cigarettes, cigars, pipes or the use of chewing tobacco. People who consume large amounts of alcohol and tobacco are at an even greater risk. Other risk factors include HPV infection (a sexually transmitted virus), facial sun exposure, and a previous diagnosis of oral cancer. A quick, painless oral cancer exam by a medical provider or dentist may detect oral cancer.
<b>Oral health examination</b>	A clinical, visual, and tactile inspection and investigation of the hard and soft structures of the mouth for purposes of assessment, diagnosis, planning, treatment, and evaluation.
<b>Oral health screening</b>	A brief assessment of the mouth to identify oral diseases and to provide guidance for management. It is not an examination and does not involve making diagnoses that lead to treatment plans.
<b>Oral surgery</b>	Surgical procedures in the mouth, such as pulling of teeth.
<b>Orofacial anomalies</b>	Atypical conditions of the head and face, especially as a result of hereditary or congenital defects. Also called craniofacial anomalies.
<b>Pediatric dentistry</b>	Dental services for children from birth through adolescence.
<b>Periodontal treatment</b>	A part of preventive dental services that involves the removal of tartar below the gum surface. Also part of a dental cleaning.

<b>Preventive dental services</b>	Refers to measures taken to prevent diseases including fluoride treatments and dental sealants.
<b>Prosthetic dental services</b>	Services to restore the dental function, comfort, appearance, and health of patients with clinical conditions associated with missing or deficient teeth; tooth replacement services such as caps (crowns), bridges, and/or dentures (plates).
<b>Radiographs</b>	Pictures of the teeth, bones, and surrounding soft tissue to diagnose, screen for and help identify problems with the teeth, mouth, and jaw. Also known as dental x-rays.
<b>Restorative services</b>	Mostly refers to dental fillings. Some programs also may offer prosthetic services such as caps (crowns), bridges, and/or dentures (plates). Please call program.
<b>School-based dental program</b>	Dental services provided directly in the school environment; can range from a limited, focused program such as provision of dental sealants to other prevention services to comprehensive dental services.
<b>Sliding fee scale</b>	Treatment fees vary based on financial resources.
<b>Statewide Service Provider</b>	County of residence does not apply to this site. Other eligibility requirements may apply.
<b>Third-party payer</b>	Any payer other than the patient, for health care services, such as an insurance company, HMO, PPO, or the government.
<b>Treatment planning</b>	A schedule of procedures and appointments designed to restore, step by step, a patient's oral health.

<b>Underinsured</b>	Not having sufficient insurance to cover dental care services; not having proper health insurance.
<b>Uninsured</b>	Not covered by private or public (Medicaid) dental insurance.
<b>Urgent care services</b>	Emergency care; pain relief for acute care needs. Often for unscheduled, walk-in patients.
<b>Walk-in patients</b>	Unscheduled appointments usually associated with dental emergency or urgent care services.
<b>X-rays</b>	Pictures of the teeth, bones, and surrounding soft tissues to diagnose, screen for, and help identify problems with the teeth, mouth, and jaw. Also known as dental radiographs.

# Fluoride and Water Testing Laboratories

## Q. What is fluoride?

A. Fluoride is a natural element found in rocks and soil, in fresh water, and in ocean water. Waters in and around the United States have natural fluoride levels that range from 0.1 to more than 12 parts per million (ppm). One ppm is like one cent in \$10,000.00. The optimal fluoride level for a community water system is 0.6 ppm - 1.0 ppm.

## Q. What are the benefits of fluoridated water?

A. Fluoridated water:

- Prevents tooth decay
- Strengthens tooth enamel
- Kills germs that cause tooth decay
- Is a cost-effective means of improving community health

More than 50 years of evidence supports the effectiveness of fluoridated water and its ability to prevent, reduce, or even reverse the onset and development of tooth decay. Through continuous research, drinking optimally fluoridated water has been scientifically proven to be safe, not toxic, and effective.

In 2020, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported approximately 72.7 percent of Americans drink fluoridated water. CDC also reported that Maryland ranked ninth in the country for residents on community water systems with access to fluoridated water (93.7 percent).

The addition of supplemental fluoride to drinking water can be compared to the addition of supplemental Vitamin D to milk:

- Both fluoride and vitamin D occur naturally and provide significant health benefits when present in a person's diet at sufficient levels
- Sufficient levels of Vitamin D in a person's diet can prevent rickets in children and bone disease in adults. Sufficient levels of fluoride in a person's drinking water can reduce tooth decay and strengthen tooth enamel

## Q. Should I have the water tested to determine the fluoride level?

A. Many places in Maryland add fluoride to their community water systems as a cost efficient and effective way to help reduce tooth decay.

If you do not know the concentration of fluoride in your community water supply or drink well water, it is important to contact your local health department and/or have it tested, before taking any fluoride supplements.

Consult your medical or dental provider before making any decisions.
