Because our patients are important to us, we take important steps to protect you and your health.

These Steps Include:

Performing hand hygiene

... by washing our hands before and after patient care with soap and water or using an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

Wearing gloves

. . . each time hands are in any part of the mouth. Gloves are changed between each patient.

Disposing of used needles and sharp objects

... by placing them in a puncture proof container.

Putting on a mask, eye protection, and gown

. . . so everyone is protected from splash or splatter of blood or body fluids.

Sterilizing all dental instruments and using FDAapproved devices

. . . including dental handpieces (dental drills).

Cleaning our surroundings and equipment

. . . by using surface cleaners and disinfectants and following the infection control guidelines published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
