Tina Backe provided an update on CHW training program accreditation from Sept. 1, 2019- Nov. 14, 2022. Applications - 21, Applications in review process - 6, Accreditations - 15

Most recently accredited training programs: Montgomery County DHHS is the first accredited fully Spanish training curriculum; Voice of Hope, Inc. has a focus on Peer Recovery.
