Building the Infrastructure to Bill for Services

Having a strong billing infrastructure in place is essential and can maximize efficiencies in all areas of the LHD. The initial set up of the billing infrastructure (or foundation) impacts staff from the appointment scheduler and front office, to the clinic and billing staff.

LHD staff plays an important role in patient outcomes and the revenue cycle. Maximizing efficiencies in workflow and processes can reduce compliance risks, improve reporting capabilities and increase revenue.
