Dear Maryland Medicaid Provider:

This is an update to inform you that the Maryland Department of Health (MDH) has restored critical operations impacting our Medicaid providers following a recent security incident:

- The MDH Electronic Data Interchange Transaction Processing System (EDITPS) is now AVAILABLE.
- Providers may now submit Fee For Services claims (837s).
- WebEVS, or recipient Eligibility Verification System, is now AVAILABLE.
- Due to the volume moving through EDITPS, there is a possibility that claims submitted toward the end of the week may be delayed by an additional week.
- No additional action is required for pharmacies, behavioral health and dental providers, or providers whose claims are submitted via LTSSMaryland.

We appreciate your patience as we work to get EDITPS back online quickly.
