Policy Title	Effective Date	Summary of Changes
Urgent Care Policy, Professional	September 1, 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Effective with dates of service on or after September 1, 2022, UnitedHealthcare will apply the Urgent Care Policy to care providers in all states. Under the policy, Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) S9083, Global Fee Urgent Care Center, is not eligible for reimbursement. Code S9083 is considered informational and does not describe the specific service(s) provided. Consistent with the Centers for Medicaid & Medicare Services (CMS), physicians and other health care professionals should report the evaluation and management, and/or procedure, code that specifically describes the services provided. Providers with existing negotiated rates for S9083 will continue to be excluded from this policy.

Policy Title	Effective Date	Summary of Changes
Provider Based Billing Policy, Professional and Facility	June 1, 2022	The Provider Based Billing reimbursement policy that was announced effective 1/1/22 will be retired effective 6/1/22.
