Adult Dental Pilot Program

Effective June I, 20 I 9, Maryland Medicaid launched an Adult Dental Pilot Program which covers limited dental benefits for adults aged 21 through 64 who are eligible for full Medicare and Medicaid benefits. The Pilot program will be administered by SKGEN USA, the Department's Dental Benefits Administrator, and utilizes the existing Maryland Healthy Smiles Dental Program provider network. There will be an annual maximum benefit allowance of \$800 per member, which will reset at the beginning of each calendar year. To ensure reimbursement of dental services, providers must submit claims immediately after the services have been rendered.
