Re: Health Care Service Delivery – contracts / written agreements

According to Health General §3-306(d), subject to the consent of the governing body and the written approval of the Secretary, a health officer for a county may enter into a contract or any other written agreement to assist or participate in the delivery of health care services with a person that is authorized to provide, finance, coordinate, facilitate, or otherwise deliver health care services in the State.

In accordance with the powers and duties vested in the Secretary and pursuant to Health General § 3-306(f), the Secretary may delegate duties, powers, and functions to a health officer for a county.

This memo delegates the authority to the local health officer to enter into contracts, on behalf of the Local Health Department, that are not subject to Health General §3-306(d). This memo also provides a comprehensive approval for all contracts under \$100,000 per year that are subject to Health General § 3-306(d). All contracts and written agreements over \$100,000 per year should be forwarded to Dr. Howard Haft's attention for review and ultimate approval by the Secretary.
