The Contractor shall provide the Department a list of providers...The Cost Report data shall reflect the most recent desk review or audited Cost Report available.

Will skilled nursing facilities be audited/verification under prospected rate setting method? Yes.

- Q. Exhibit 1 Indicates that the hours for settlements were 32053. Can you break these hours between desk reviews, audit, and settlements?
