**ORDER OF MODIFICATION**

The Maryland Board of Examiners of Psychologists (the "Board") is in receipt of a request from Shane Perrault, License No. 4005, asking for modification of the terms of the Consent Order, dated May 11, 2012. Based on extenuating personal and financial circumstances, Dr. Perrault requests an extension of time in order to pay the Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) due to the complainants in this matter. Upon consideration of Dr. Perrault's request, the Board voted to modify the terms of its Consent Order as ordered below.

**ORDER**

It is this 7<sup>th</sup> day of Dec., 2012, by an affirmative vote of the Maryland Board of Examiners of Psychologists, hereby,

**ORDERED** that Dr. Perrault pay Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) to the complainants in this matter no later than June 3, 2013; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that all of the other terms of the May 11, 2012, Consent Order remain in full force and effect; and be it further,

**ORDERED** that this is a modification to a formal order of the Maryland Board of Examiners of Psychologists and as such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Article, Section 10-617(h).
