**Ethics tutorial trainer**: The Board recommends that a licensee take an ethics tutorial class to assist the licensee with the laws and regulations governing the psychology practice. The licensee is responsible for all costs associated with the ethics tutorial.

**Peer Supervisor:** Peer Supervisors play a crucial role in providing supportive peer supervision to licensed psychologists. They are particularly useful in standard-of-care situations, offering reassurance and support. The licensee, as a professional, is responsible for all costs associated with peer supervision.

**Competency Expert**: Competency experts are used in judicial proceedings and submit expert reports and testimony at hearings. The Board provides compensation for expert services.

To serve in one of these roles, the psychologist must hold an active license, be in good standing for a minimum of five years and have no history of adverse disciplinary actions.
