## General Information

The intent of this document is to provide general information about psychology associate registration. Please refer to the Board of Examiners of Psychologists Occupations Article 18 and COMAR 10.36.07 for a full description of the laws and regulations that govern the practice of psychology as a Psychology Associate in Maryland.

### Psychology Associate Registration

**Psychology Associate:** Psychology Associates are registered to provide psychological services under the supervision of a licensed psychologist in Maryland for a two (2) year period. Registrations are renewed every two (2) years. To apply for a psychology associate registration an applicant must submit the following:

- A completed psychology associate registration application.
- Pay the nonrefundable application fee online.
- An official transcript sent by the school (s) to the Board from an accredited college or university with at least a master's degree that meets the educational requirements in Health Occupations Article §18-302
- Submit to a Criminal History Records Check

\*The completed online application and payment must be received before a file will be established.

**The Board is not responsible for any documents received before a file is established.** Incomplete applications will **not** be reviewed. \*

Applicants who meet registration requirements will be eligible to take the Maryland Jurisprudence exam.

**Applicants with foreign degrees:** Applicants who have obtained their degree outside of the United States must have their transcripts evaluated by The World Education Services (master's degrees) or The National Register of Health Service Psychologists (doctorate degrees). The results of the evaluation must be sent directly from these organizations to the Board.

**Application for Registration from Nonresidents:** An applicant who is not a Maryland resident nor employed in Maryland must include a statement in the application addressing the reason why they are seeking to become a registered psychology associate in Maryland.

**Veterans and Spousal Preference:** Pursuant to the Veterans Full Employment Act of 2013, the application of a veteran or spouse of a veteran who discharged from active duty under circumstances other than a dishonorable discharge with one (1) year of filing an application will be expedited.

### **Registered Psychology Associates**

**Reinstatement:** Refers to a license or registration on non-renewed status for less than five (5) years. To apply for reinstatement, the licensee/psychology associate must submit a reinstatement application, complete continuing education hours from the current reporting period, and pay the reinstatement fee.

\*A new application is required after five (5) years.
