

Unintentional Drug- and Alcohol-Related Intoxication Deaths in Maryland, 2023

Preliminary data update through 3rd quarter: January – September

Release Date: February 2024

This report contains counts of unintentional drug- and alcohol-related intoxication deaths* occurring in Maryland through the 3rd quarter of 2023, the most recent period for which preliminary data are available. Counts are also shown for the same period of 2010-2022 to allow for review of trends over time. Counts for 2022 and 2023 are not complete and are subject to change.

Since an intoxication death may involve more than one substance, counts of deaths related to specific substances do not sum to the total number of deaths.

*Deaths resulting from recent ingestion or exposure to alcohol or other types of drugs, including heroin, prescription opioids, prescribed and illicit forms of fentanyl (including carfentanil), cocaine, benzodiazepines, phencyclidine (PCP), methamphetamines and other prescribed and unprescribed drugs.

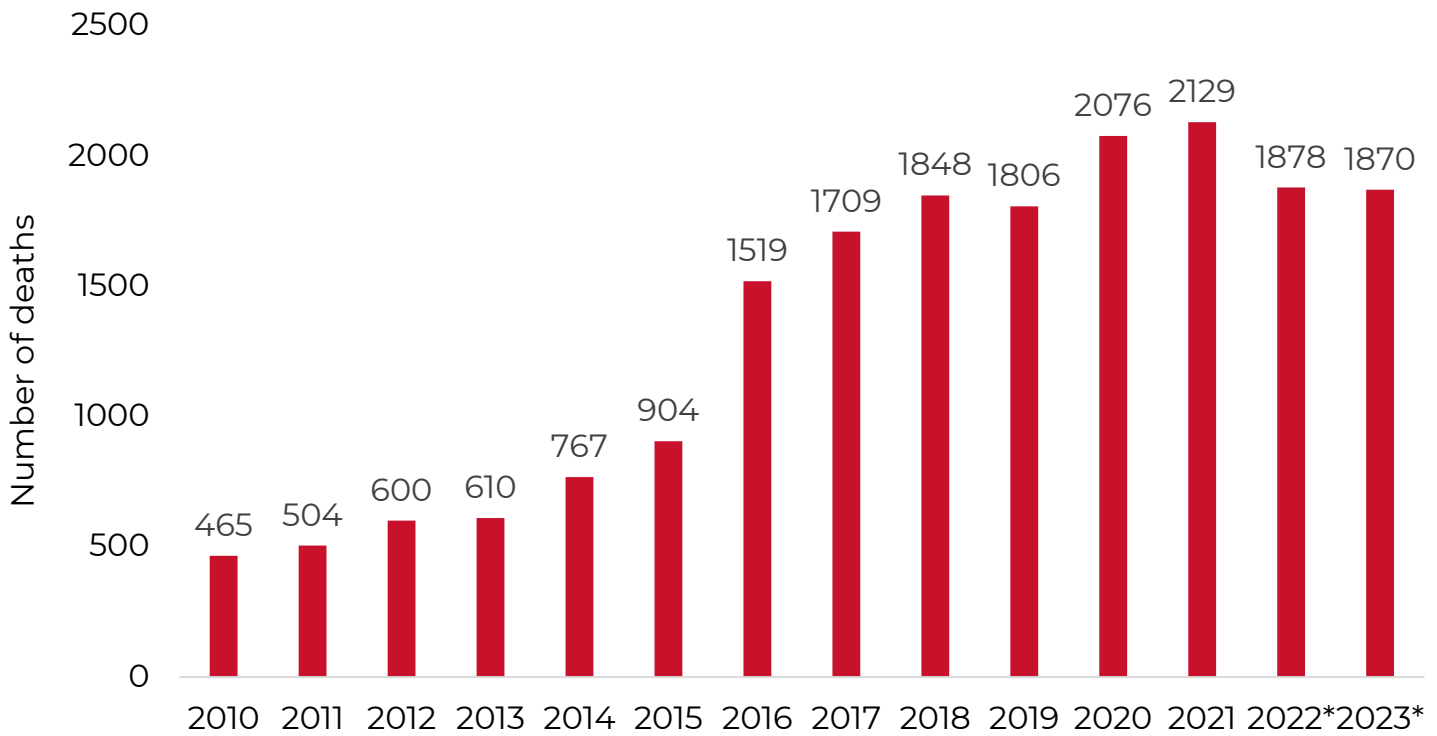

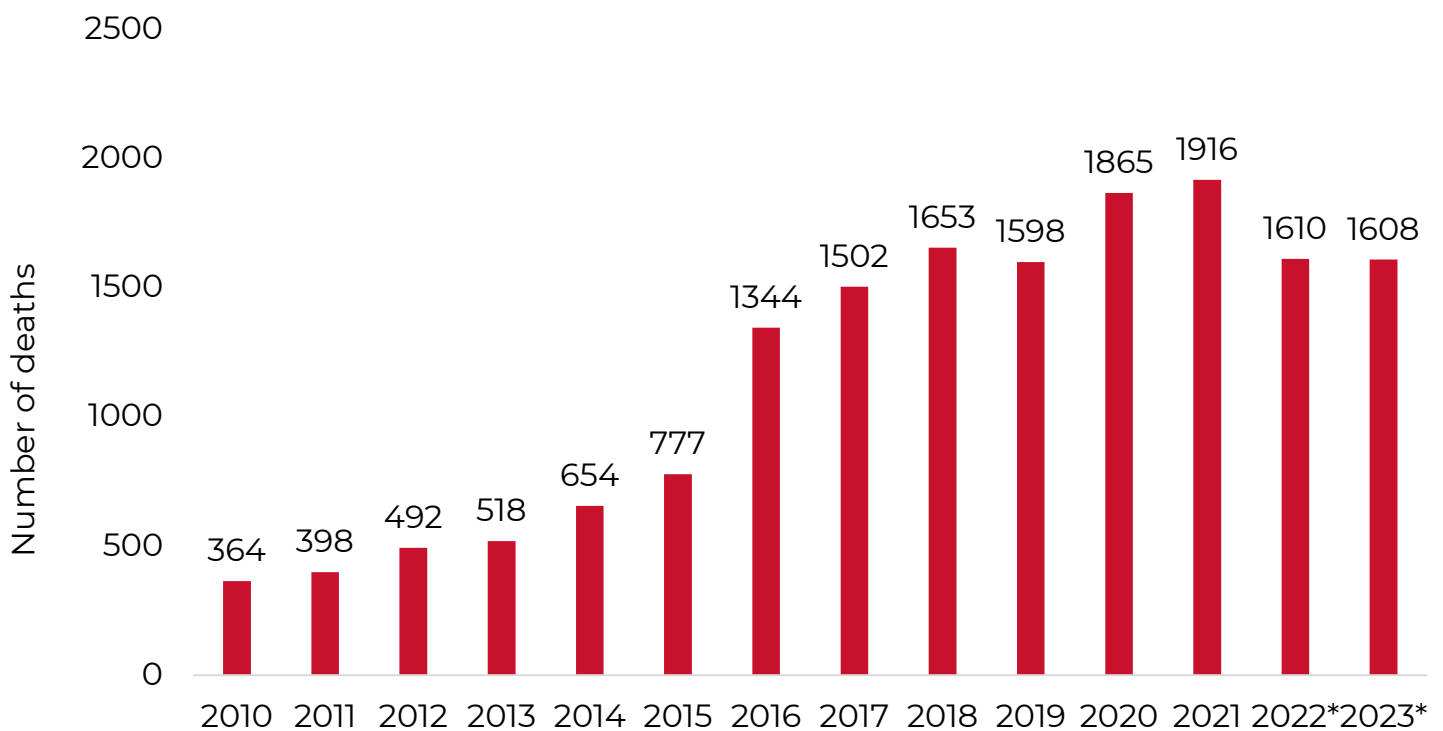
Figure 1. Total Number of Unintentional Drug- and Alcohol-Related Intoxication Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

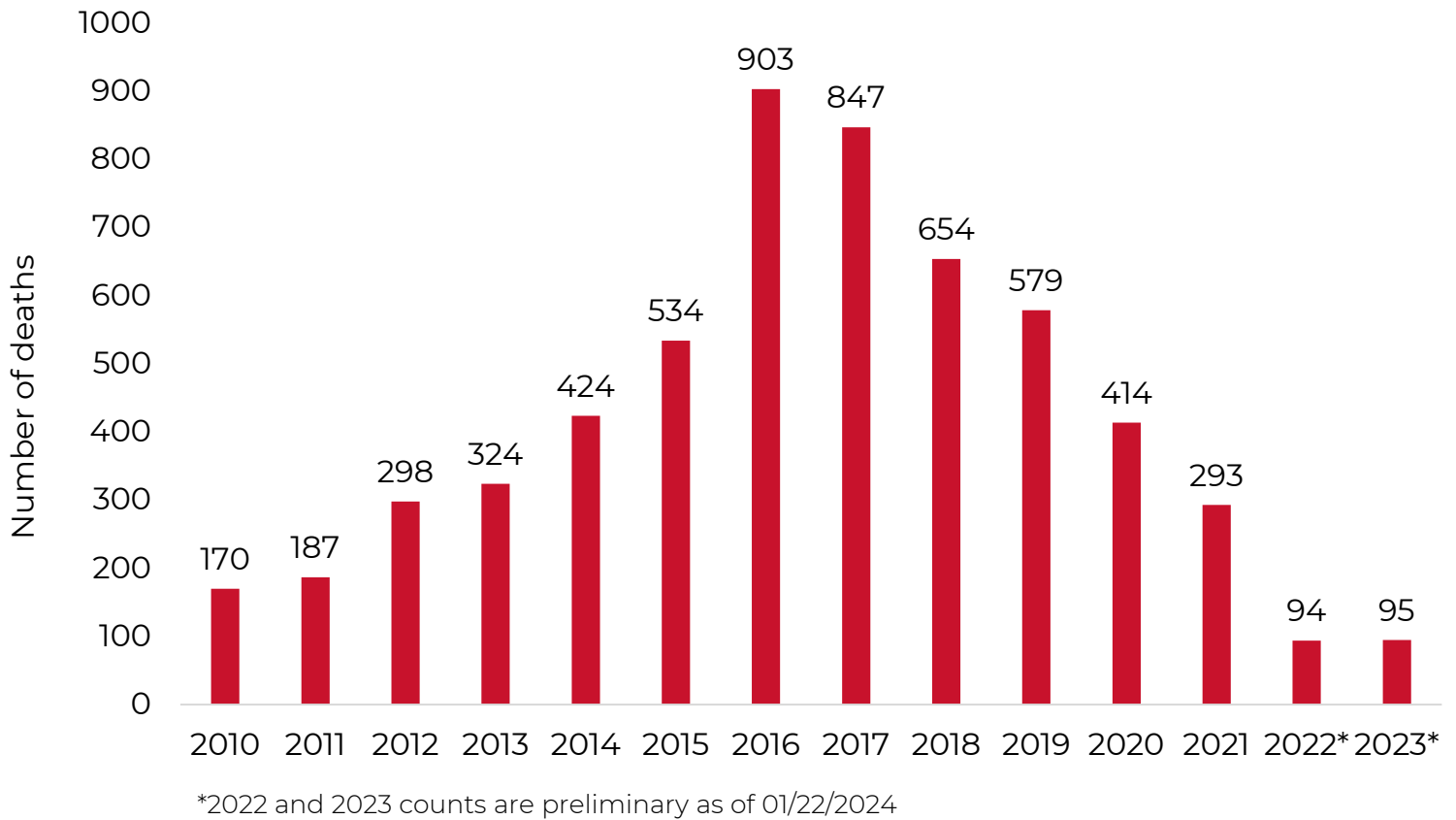
Figure 2. Number of Unintentional Opioid-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

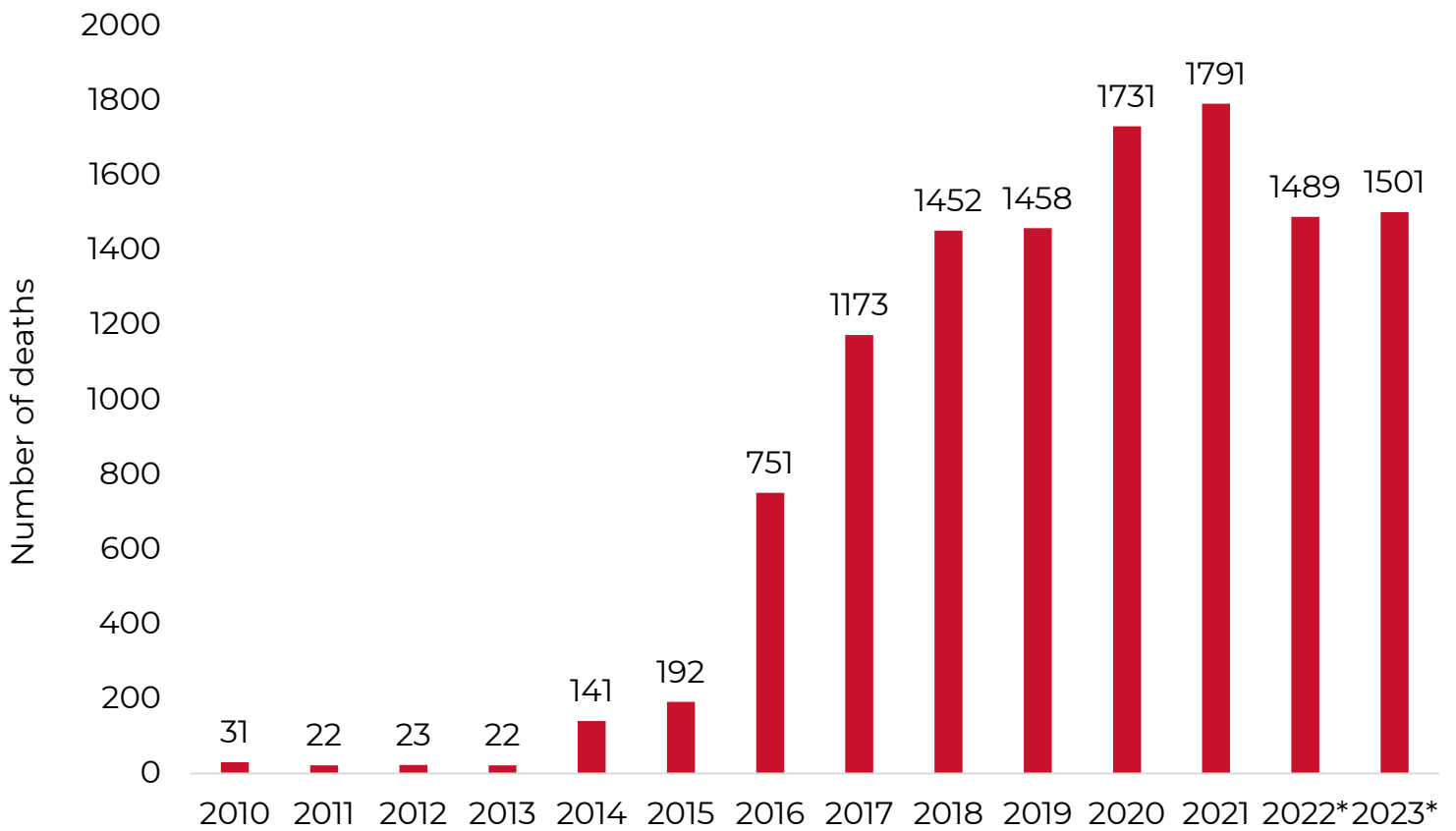

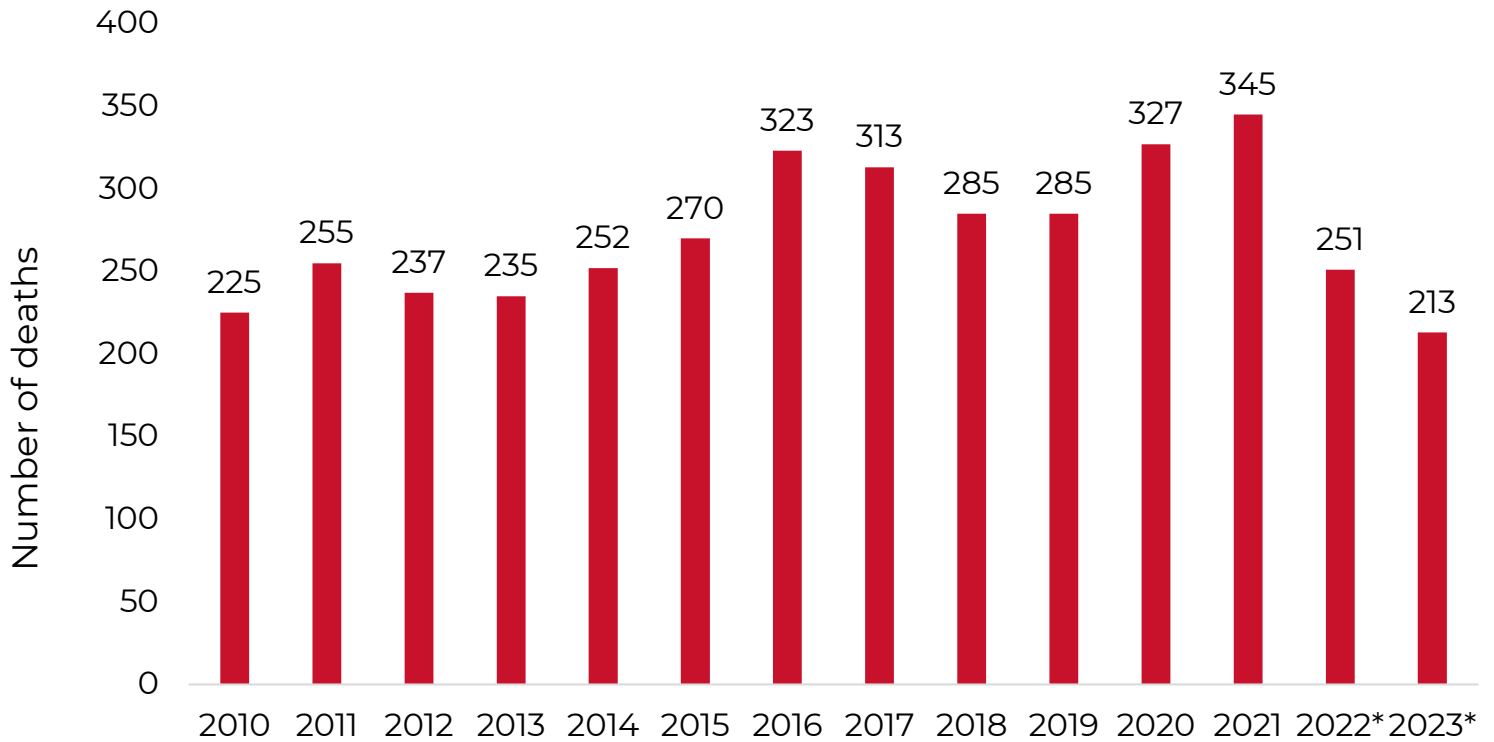
Figure 4. Number of Unintentional Fentanyl-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

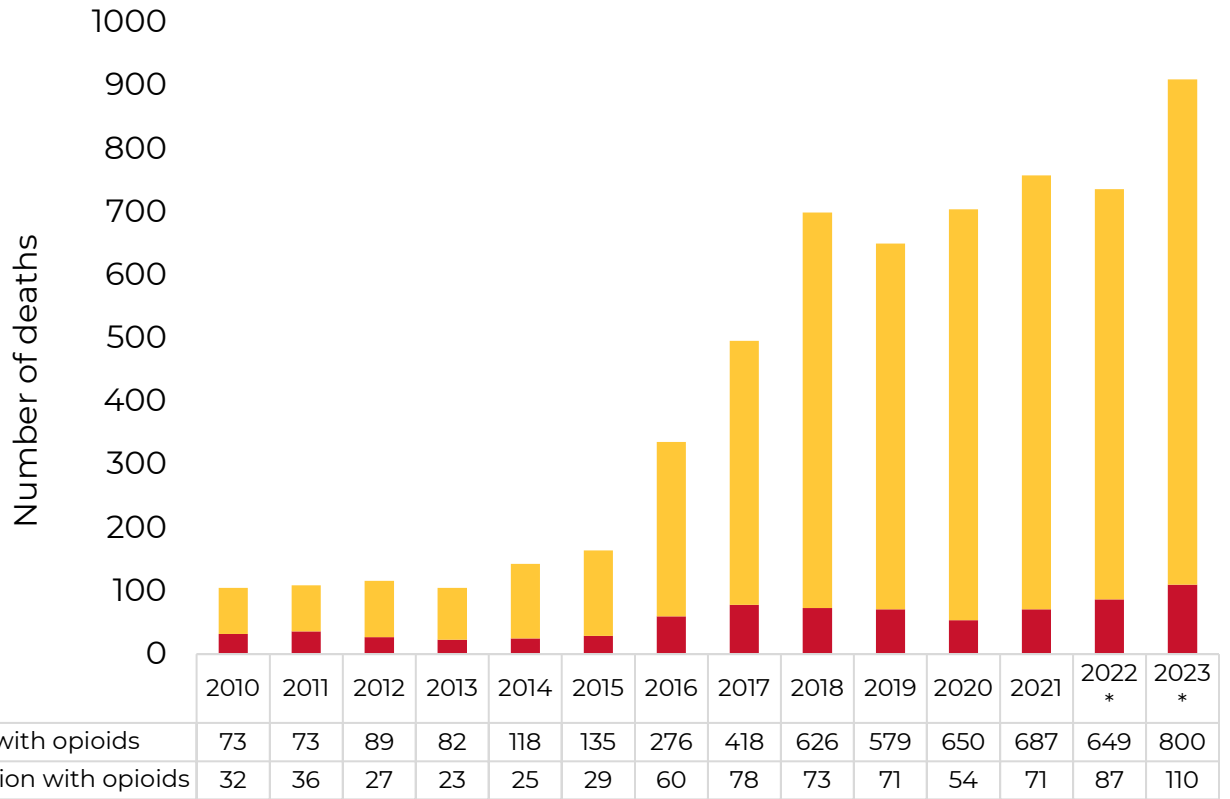
Figure 5. Number of Unintentional Prescription Opioid-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

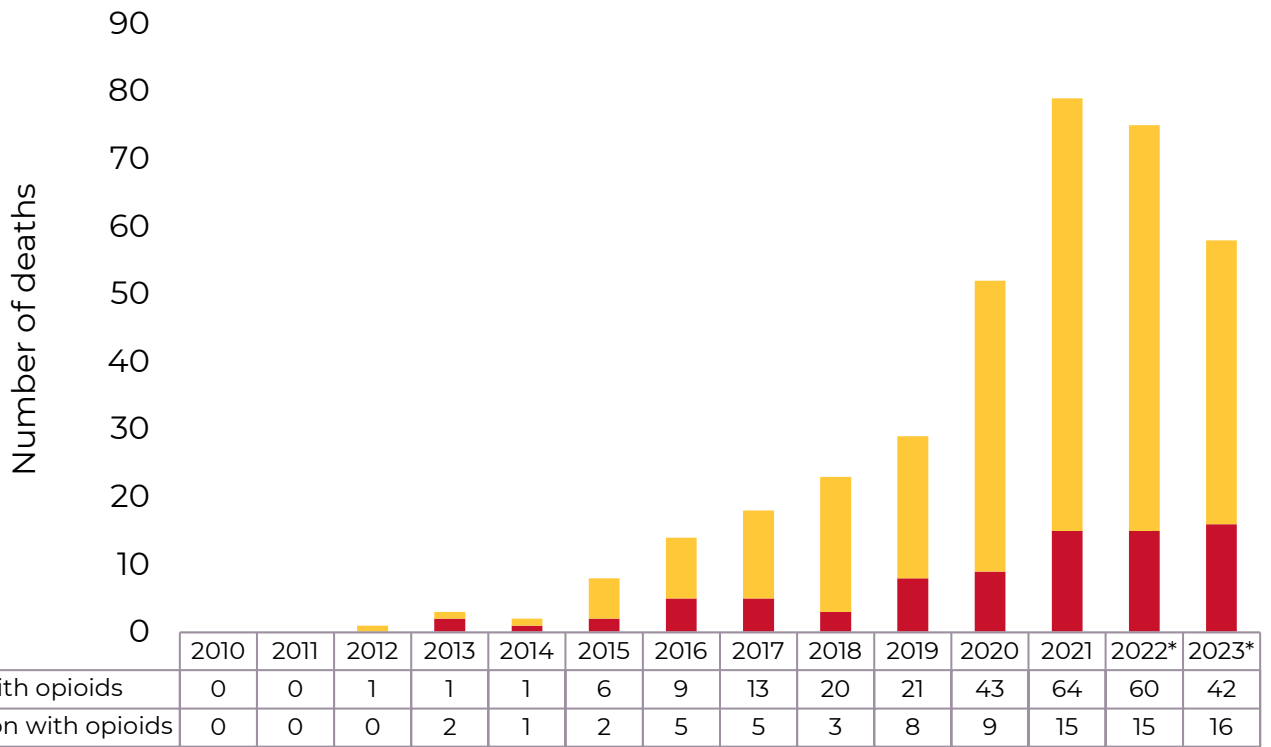
Figure 6. Number of Unintentional Cocaine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

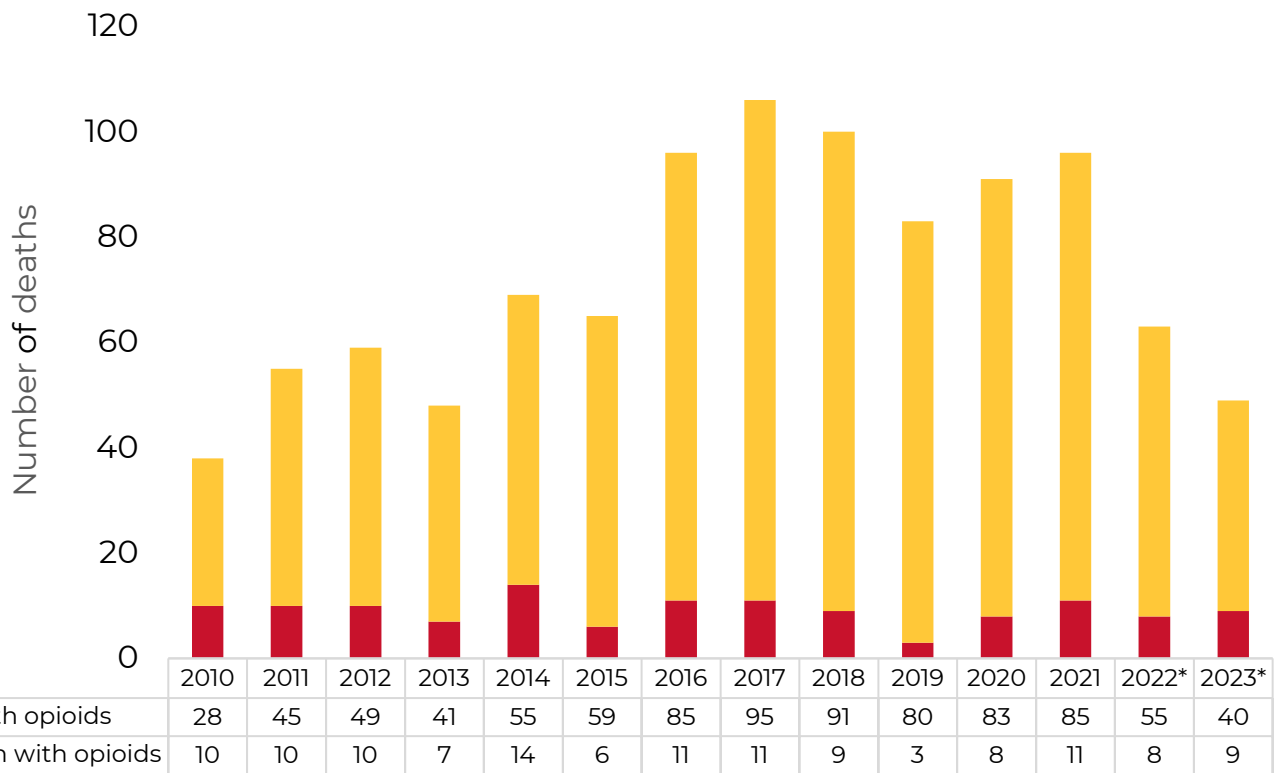
Figure 7. Number of Unintentional Methamphetamine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

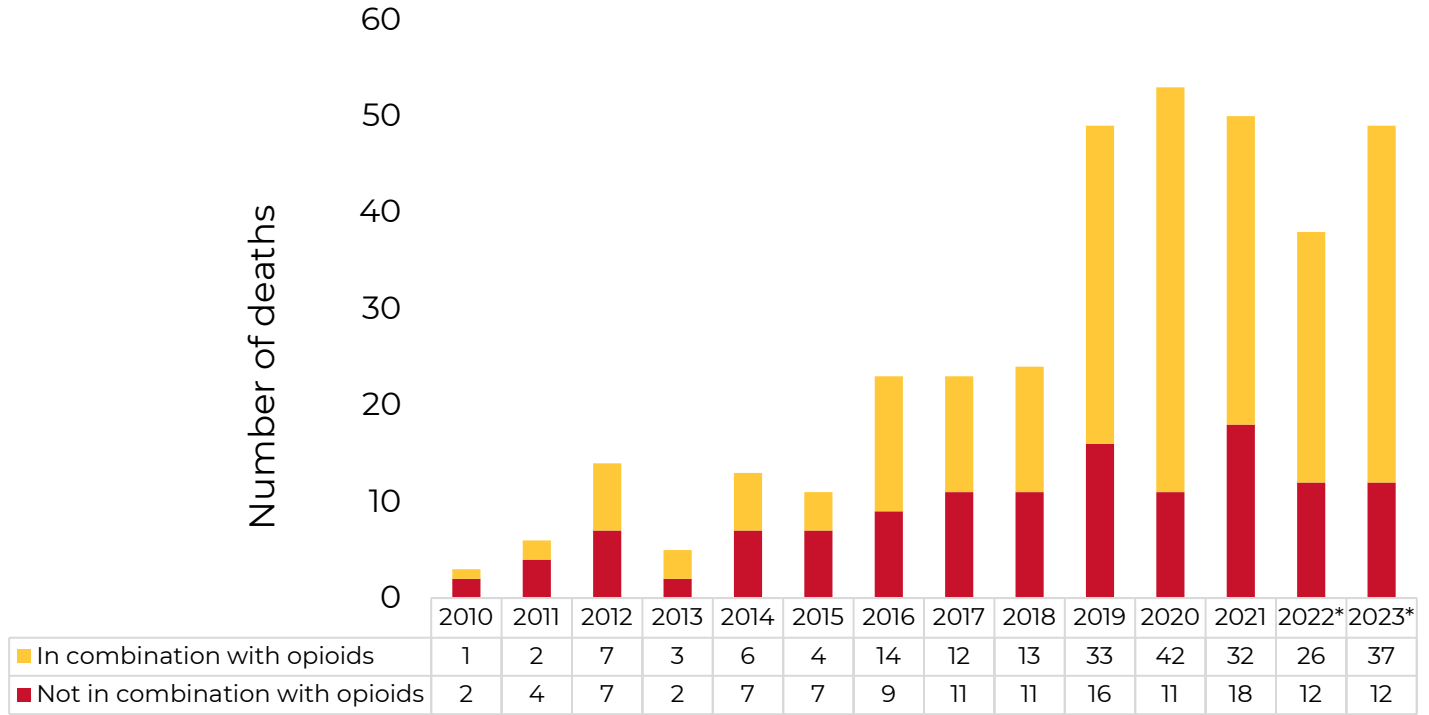
Figure 8. Number of Unintentional Benzodiazepine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*

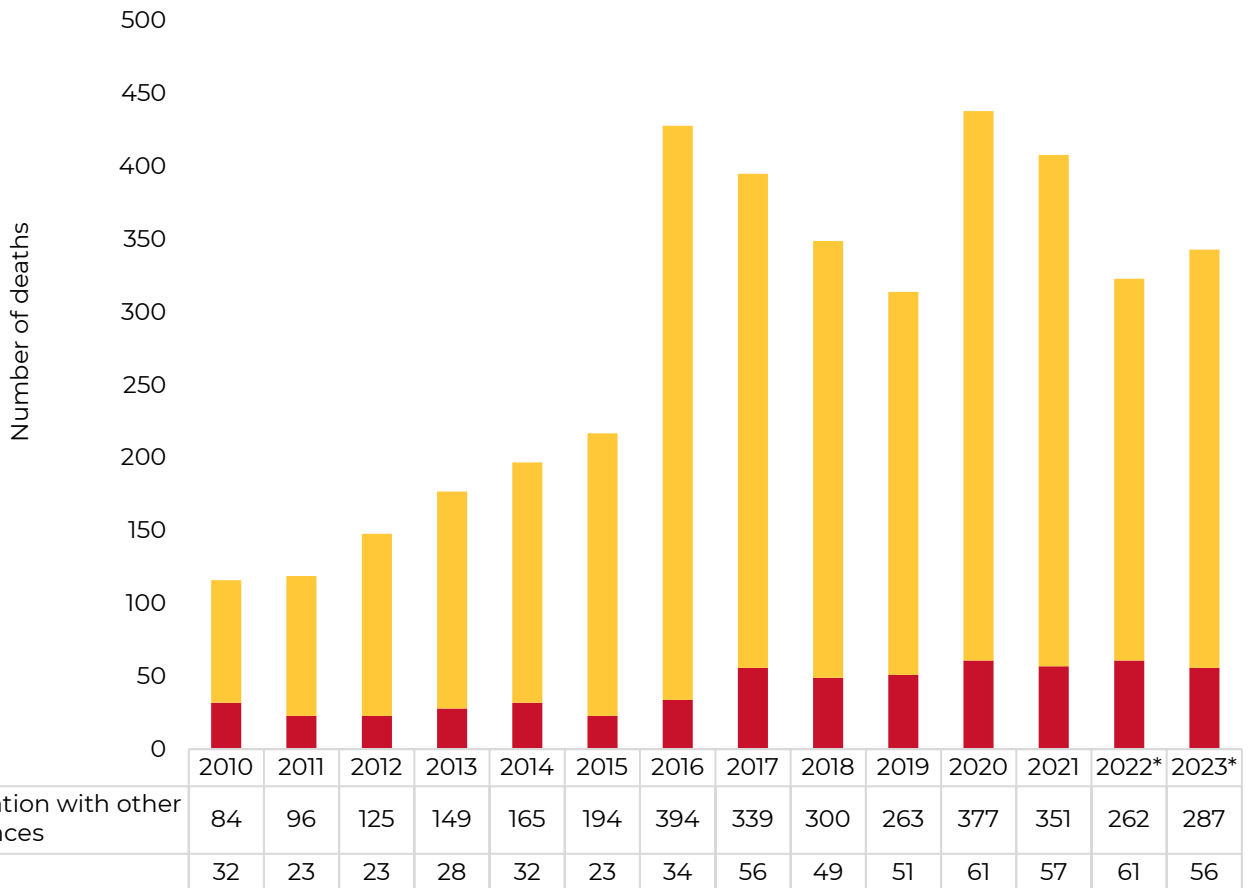
Figure 9. Number of Unintentional Phencyclidine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-September of Each Year.*
