Preliminary data update through 1st quarter: January – March

Release Date: July 2024

This report contains counts of unintentional drug- and alcohol-related intoxication deaths* occurring in Maryland through the 1st quarter of 2024, the most recent period for which preliminary data are available. Counts are also shown for the same period of 2011-2023 to allow for review of trends over time. Counts for 2023 and 2024 are not complete and are subject to change.

Since an intoxication death may involve more than one substance, counts of deaths related to specific substances do not sum to the total number of deaths.

*Deaths resulting from recent ingestion or exposure to alcohol or other types of drugs, including heroin, prescription opioids, prescribed and illicit forms of fentanyl (including carfentanil), cocaine, benzodiazepines, phencyclidine (PCP), methamphetamines and other prescribed and unprescribed drugs.





Figure 1. Total Number of Unintentional Drug- and Alcohol-Related Intoxication Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*




OPIOID-RELATED DEATHS

Figure 2. Number of Unintentional Opioid-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*




HEROIN-RELATED DEATHS

Figure 3. Number of Unintentional Heroin-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*




FENTANYL-RELATED DEATHS

Figure 4. Number of Unintentional Fentanyl-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*




PRESCRIPTION OPIOID-RELATED DEATHS


Figure 6. Number of Unintentional Cocaine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*


Figure 7. Number of Unintentional Methamphetamine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*


Figure 8. Number of Unintentional Benzodiazepine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*


Figure 9. Number of Unintentional Phencyclidine-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*


Figure 10. Number of Unintentional Alcohol-Related Deaths Occurring in Maryland from January-March of Each Year.*
