Who Should Attend?

If you are concerned that a loved one is at risk for overdosing on heroin or a prescription pain medication, this training is for you.

What will you learn?

Training Participants will learn:

- Opioid types
- How to recognize, respond to, and prevent an opioid overdose
- How to administer intra-nasal naloxone to reverse an overdose.

What is Naloxone?

It is a prescription medication that reverses an opioid overdose. It cannot be used to get high and it is not addictive.

What will I get for completing the training?

You will receive one 4 mg dose of naloxone and an overdose prevention kit.

(Residency restrictions apply for the naloxone prescription)
