ALLEGANY COVID-19 CASE COUNT CLIMBS TO 142 New cases include 12 nursing home residents and two community members.

CUMBERLAND, MD – The Allegany County Health Department reports 14 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 on Wednesday as the county's case tally climbs to 142. Among the new cases are six Cumberland Healthcare Center residents, six residents of Sterling Care Frostburg Village, and two Allegany County community members – a male in his 50s and a female in her 60s who are both recovering at home.

To date, 1,194 Allegany County residents have been tested for COVID-19, with 142 positive, 976 negative, and 76 tests pending.
