ONE NEW CASE OF COVID-19 IDENTIFIED IN MALE CHC RESIDENT

CUMBERLAND, MD – A new case of COVID-19 has been identified in a male resident of Cumberland Healthcare Center. The man has underlying medical conditions and is currently hospitalized. This brings the county's total cases to 143.

As of Friday, 1,242 Allegany County residents have been tested for COVID-19. Of those, 1,053 are negative, 143 have tested positive, and 46 tests are still pending.
