ALLEGANY COVID CASES NOW AT 278, SEVEN NEW CASES SINCE MONDAY

CUMBERLAND, MD – The cumulative number of COVID-19 cases in Allegany County has increased to 278, with seven new cases reported since Monday. The latest cases include a resident of Devlin Manor Nursing and Rehabilitation Center and six Allegany County community members – two males and two females in their 20s, a male in his 50s and a female in her 70s. None have been hospitalized.
