SEVEN NEW CASES OF COVID-19, TWO DEATHS IN ALLEGANY COUNTY

CUMBERLAND, MD – The Allegany County Health Department reports that one community member in their 70s and a second person who was a nursing home resident have died from COVID-19. Since Friday, there have been seven new cases of COVID-19 identified in Allegany County including a male and female in their teens, four females in their 20s, and a male in his 50s. None of the new cases have required hospitalization. This brings the cumulative number of cases in Allegany County to 411.

A free drive-thru COVID-19 testing event is being held at the Allegany County Fairgrounds today, Wednesday, September 9 from 1 to 6 p.m. Participants are asked to bring an ID and remain in their vehicles.
