Behavioral Health Administration (BHA) Maryland Opioid Rapid Response (MORR) State Targeted Response (STR) Bi-Monthly Data Reports

This report is used to gather bi-monthly treatment outcomes from each jurisdiction. (Crisis: Allegany County, Anne Arundel County, Behavioral Health System Baltimore, and MidShore/Kent County; 3.1 Residential: Allegany County, MidShore/Kent, Washington County, Worcester County

Jurisdictions are to send the reports twice per month on the 15th and the 30th.

This report contains bi-weekly jurisdictional outcomes for provider screenings, referrals to treatment, new admissions, refusals to treatment, Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT), recovery support services, such as peer support, outcomes regarding referrals to next level of care, and ancillary services

Once reports come in from the jurisdictions by email, download and electronically file each report. All 8 jurisdictions have their bi-monthly reports saved to its respective folder.

A Maryland Department of Health (MDH Performance Measures Document) was created to capture the data from these bi-monthly reports. All data received from the jurisdictions are recorded on the MDH Performance Document that is a shared Google Document.
