Contractual Health Occupations Investigator Position

The Board's full-time contractual investigator position is now vacant, and the position has been re-posted. The goal is to have this position filled by the end of January, 2020.

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NAB Mid-Year Meeting

Ms. Hill stated that is was a very informative meeting, where the emphasis was still on the states adopting the HSE. NAB leaders stated that they were building their outreach program, and that Boards could now have the CE registry downloaded to their systems for renewal purposes; unfortunately, our licensing system is not capable of allowing that to happen.

Legislative Committee Update - October 29, 2019 Meeting and Board Votes

The Board reviewed and Ms. Washington discussed two draft bills (one for licensing assisted living managers and another that addresses removing the association recommendation requirement for appointment to the Board and providing the Board more flexibility in setting provisional license effective periods). The proposed legislation that was submitted to MDH in May, as proposed departmental bills, were rejected by MDH. Therefore, the Board will need private sponsors in order to move the legislation forward. Ms. Washington noted that the Board would need to vote on acquiring sponsors and submitting the bills for the 2020 legislative session. Ms. Washington stated that if this bill were to become law, the composition of the Board would change and Nursing Home Administrators and Assisted Living Managers would both be classified as licensees of the Board. The Board voted to seek private sponsors and submit the bills for the 2020 legislative session.

Presentation

Board Chair Anthony read the service award that will be given to Board Member Ms. Margie Heald, who is retiring.

Meeting Adjournment

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded and unanimously carried. The meeting was adjourned at 10:27 a.m.

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
