- III. Reports:
  - A. Chair:
  - i. Introduction of Lynn Duffy, Psy.D, LCPC, newly appointed to Board.
  - ii. Discussion regarding interactions and outcome of situation involving an individual who was a client of a licensee and who filed grievances against Board members and staff.
  - B. Board Counsel No report.
  - C. Legislation/Regulations Committee (Link/Reese):
  - Hearings on Sunset Extension held January 30, 2020 and February 6, 2020; both bills crossed over; there are no anticipated issues regarding the bill.

- HB42/SB67 Public Information Act Application for Inspection Responses and Time Limits. House hearing February 11, 2020, Senate hearing March 10, 2020; Kim Link testified that the Board would have difficulty responding to PIAs in the shortened time period provided in the bill.
- HB448/SB Health Care Practitioners Telehealth, Senate hearing February 13, 2020 and House hearing February 18, 2020; Kim Link testified at both hearings regarding the Board's position against the ability to provide counseling/therapy services solely through asynchronous interactions.
- HB820 Child Abuse and Neglect Training of Health Care Professionals, House hearing February 20, 2020; Board took no position on bill.
- HB639 Public Health Cultural Competency Coursework or Training, House hearing February 26, 2020; Board took no position on bill.
- SB766/HB1102 Maryland Music Therapists Act, Senate hearing February 26, 2020, House hearing March 5, 2020; Kim Link, Mark Donovan, and Nicki Drotleff will testify in opposition on February 26, 2020. Witnesses needed for March hearing.
- HB1616 Health Occupations Boards Uniform Record Keeping Requirements; Motion to oppose HB1616; Motion carried, unanimously.
- D. Credentialing Committee (Bolden): Committee considered one application seeking to use undergraduate appraisal course for LCPC; request was denied. Committee also considered request of applicant who applied in 2013 to sit for the NCE again without having to reapply; request denied. Request to use hours earned in Florida toward LCPC; allowed up to 1000 hours earned during internship. Discussion regarding accepting California state MFT exam. Katrinic to research if the exam is "normed" and will report back to the Board.
- E. Discipline Review Committee (Ganel): The committee continues to meet monthly.
- F. Behavior Analyst Advisory Committee (Link): No report.
