ORDER OF TERMINATION OF PROBATION

On or about December 20, 2013, the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice (the "Board") executed a "Consent Order," which, among other things, placed Bryan J. Wodaski, license number 03241 (the "Petitioner") on probation for a minimum of three (3) years subject to certain probationary terms and conditions. The Petitioner has recently petitioned the Board to terminate the probation upon his license. The Board considered the Petition and has decided to terminate the probation imposed by the December 20, 2013 Order based upon the Petitioner's satisfactory compliance with the probationary terms set forth in that Order.

Wherefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the probation and all associated terms and conditions imposed upon Bryan J. Wodaski, license number 03241, as set forth in the "Consent Order" dated December 20, 2013 are hereby **LIFTED AND TERMINATED** and those terms and conditions have no further force and effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a Final Decision and Order of the Maryland Board of Occupational Therapy Practice and as such is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., General Provisions §§ 4-101 *et seq.*
