Re: Surrender of License to Practice Social Work

Dear Ms. Capaci and Members of the Board:

Please be advised that I have decided to **SURRENDER** my license to practice social work in the State of Maryland, License Number 18024.

I understand that I may not give social work advice or treatment to any individual, with or without supervision and/or compensation, cannot counsel, diagnose or provide therapy to people or otherwise engage in the practice of clinical social work, as it is defined in the Social Work Practice Act (the "Act"), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. ("Health Occ.") § 19-101 *et seq.* (2014 Repl. Vol.).

In addition, I have refrained from identifying myself as a practitioner of social work since my license expired on October 31, 2014, and will continue to refrain from identifying myself as a practitioner of social work. Since October 31, 2014, I have removed all signs or similar advertisements that indicate authority to practice social work; and I will not use any signs, advertisements, letterhead, business cards, or resumes indicating authority to practice social work.

As of the effective date of this Letter of Surrender, I understand that the surrender of my license means that I am in the same position as an unlicensed individual in the State of Maryland. I understand that this Letter of Surrender is a **PUBLIC** document and on the Board's acceptance becomes a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board.

My decision to surrender my license to practice social work in the State of Maryland has been prompted by an investigation of my licensure by the Maryland State Board of Social Work Examiners (the "Board") and the Office of the Attorney General and subsequent Charges under the following provisions of the Act, Health Occ. § 19-311:

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 19-312 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license to any applicant, fine a licensee, reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the applicant or licensee:

- (4) Commits any act of ... misconduct in the practice of social work;
- (5) Engages in a course of conduct that is inconsistent with generally accepted professional standards in the practice of social work;
- (6) Violates any provision of this title or regulations governing the practice of social work adopted and published by the Board[.]

The pertinent provisions of Md. Code Regs. ("COMAR"), the Code of Ethics, provide the following:

COMAR 10.42.03.05. Relationships.

- A. The licensee may not enter into a dual relationship with a client or an individual with whom the client has a close personal relationship.
...
- C. The licensee may not engage in sexual misconduct with either current or former clients.

The Board's investigation was based on a complaint from a licensed social worker. The complainant alleged that I was romantically involved with a former client. I participated fully and honestly with the Board's investigation. As a result of the Board's investigation, the Board issued a "Notice of Charges Under the Maryland Social Work Practice Act" in Board Case Number 2015-2084, which is attached and incorporated into this Letter of Surrender. (See Attachment A). There is no allegation that my behavior was predatory or criminal in nature.

I have decided to surrender my license to practice social work in the State of Maryland to resolve this matter and to avoid prosecution of the charges against me by the Board. Furthermore, I have not practiced social work since August 2013; and my license expired on October 31, 2014. I wish to make it clear that I have voluntarily, knowingly and freely chosen to submit this Letter of Surrender. I acknowledge that the Office of the Attorney General has legally sufficient evidence to prove by a preponderance of the evidence at an administrative hearing that I violated the Act as detailed herein.

I understand that by executing this Letter of Surrender I am waiving any right to contest Board's charges in a formal evidentiary hearing at which I would have had the right to counsel, to confront witnesses, to give testimony, to call witnesses on my own behalf and all other substantive and procedural protections provided by law, including the right to appeal.

I acknowledge that on or before the effective date of this Letter of Surrender, I shall present to the Board my Maryland social work license, including any renewal certificates and wallet-sized renewal cards in my possession.

I understand that the Board will advise the Association of State Boards of Social Work, the National Practitioner's Data Bank, and the Health Care Integrity Data Bank, and any other required entities of this Letter of Surrender, and in response to any inquiry, will advise that I have surrendered my license in lieu of disciplinary action under the Act as a resolution of the matters pending against me. I also understand that, in the event that I would apply for licensure in any form in any other state or jurisdiction, that this Letter of Surrender may be released or published by the Board to the same extent as a Final Order that would result from disciplinary action pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't § 10-611 *et seq.* (2014 Repl. Vol.); and that all underlying documents may be released to the other state or jurisdiction. Finally, I understand that this Letter of Surrender is considered a disciplinary action by the Board.

I further recognize and agree that by submitting this Letter of Surrender my license will remain surrendered. I understand that if I apply for reinstatement or a new Maryland license, I must provide the Board with a current "fitness for duty" evaluation by a Board-approved mental health clinician and that I bear the burden of demonstrating to the Board that I meet the requirements to practice social work under the Act and that I possess good moral character, as required under Health Occ. II § 19-302(a)(3). I understand that when applying for reinstatement or new licensure, I approach the Board in the same posture as one whose license has been revoked based on the facts contained herein and that my application may be accepted or denied by the Board in its sole discretion.

I acknowledge that I may not rescind this Letter of Surrender in part or in its entirety for any reason. Finally, I wish to make clear that I have chosen not to consult with an attorney before signing this Letter of Surrender. I understand both the nature of the Board's actions and this Letter of Surrender fully. I acknowledge that I understand and comprehend the language, meaning and terms and effect of this Letter of Surrender. I make this decision knowingly and voluntarily.
