ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT AND PROBATION

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2015, the Maryland State Board of Social Work Examiners (the "Board") entered into a Consent Order with Theodora Proctor, License Number 10678, which suspended her license to practice social work in the State of Maryland;

WHEREAS, on March 08, 2019, after having received a petition to lift the suspension of her license, completion of a mental examination, and upon satisfaction of the conditions set forth in the Order, the Board hereby approves Ms. Proctor's petition to lift the suspension of her license, and reinstates the license pursuant to the Health Occupations Article ("HO") section 19-314. It is therefore:

ORDERED, that effective March 8, 2019, Ms. Proctor's license shall be REINSTATED; and it is further

ORDERED that Ms. Proctor shall be placed on PROBATION for a period of three (3) years, effective from the date of this Order of Reinstatement and Probation; and it is further

ORDERED that Ms. Proctor shall comply with the following specific terms and conditions as follows:

 Ms. Proctor shall obtain three (3) hours of face to face supervision by a Board-approved licensed certified clinical social worker.

- (a) The supervising social worker shall notify the Board in writing of his/her acceptance of the supervisory role of Ms. Proctor.
- (b) The supervision shall continue monthly for the entire three-year probationary period.
- (c) The supervisor shall meet with Ms. Proctor on a monthly basis and submit quarterly reports to the Board.
- (d) Ms. Proctor is solely responsible for ensuring that the supervising social worker submits the required quarterly reports.
- (e) The Board has sole authority over any changes in supervision and must approve and ratify any changes in supervision; and it is further

ORDERED that the Board reserves the right to review and reassess the frequency of Ms. Proctor's supervision each year; and it is further

ORDERED, that should the Board find a reason to believe that Ms. Proctor has failed to comply with the terms and conditions of probation, she will receive notice of the alleged noncompliance and a hearing. Should the Board determine a violation of the conditions of probation has occurred, said violation being proved by a preponderance of the evidence, the Board may impose any disciplinary sanction it deems appropriate under HO § 19-311; and it is further

ORDERED, that at the end of the three-year probationary period, Ms. Proctor may petition the Board for the termination of probation and full reinstatement of her Maryland social work license, provided that, at that time, Ms. Proctor is not under investigation, or no charges have been issued against her; and it is further

ORDERED, that Ms. Proctor shall not petition the Board for an early termination of probation; and it is further

ORDERED, that this a Final Order of the Maryland State Board of Social Work Examiners and as such is a PUBLIC DOCUMENT pursuant to Md. Code Ann., State Gov't Art., §§ 10-611, et seq.
