### PRE- CHARGE CONSENT ORDER

### Background

Laura Prosen, LCSW-C was included in a Post Renewal Continuing Education Audit conducted by the Maryland Board of Social Examiners (the "Board") on licenses requiring renewal by October 31, 2023. As a condition of continue licensure, licensed social workers are required to obtain forty (40) credit hours of Continuing Education Units (CEU) every two years in program and categories approved by the Board, in accordance with Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 19-309 (d) (3) (ii) and COMAR 10.42.06.03. The CEU's may all be in Category I but may not consist of more than twenty CEU's in Category II. A minimum of three CEU's, of the required forty CEU' shall focus on ethics and professional conduct, including boundary issues.

In lieu of instituting formal proceedings against Ms. Prosen for violations of the Maryland Social Workers Act, Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 19-101 et seq., the Board voted to resolve this matter by way of a Pre-Charge Consent Order. As a result, the Board and Ms. Prosen agreed to resolve this matter as set forth in this consent Order.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- At all times relevant hereto, Ms. Prosen was licensed to practice social work in Maryland, License No. 09621. Ms. Prosen was first licensed by the Board on November 6, 1997, and her license is set to expire on October 31, 2023.
- 2. All licensees are required to sign a statement on the renewal application attesting to having completed this requirement.
- 3. Ms. Prosen was chosen to be included in the Board's audit for the renewal period from November 1, 2017, to October 31, 2019. On January 8, 2020, Ms. Prosen was sent an initial notice, 2020 Post Renewal Continuing Education Audit", by the Association of Social Work Boards. The letter requested that the required continuing education documentation by February 7, 2020.

A Second letter, 2019 Post Renewal Audit was sent on February 27, 2020.

A third letter, 2019 Post Renewal Audit Problem notice was sent on

March 18, 2020.

- 4. Ms. Prosen held an active license during the time period outlined in this audit and is required to submit all continuing education documentation. In addition, she renewed her LCSW-C license on 8/30/2021 for the period November 1, 2021, to October 31, 2023.
- 5. A review of Laura S. Prosen's CEU certificates by the Board's Continuing Education
  Office revealed that she earned 18.0 category I, 0 ethics, and 0 category II continuing

Education Units. Therefore, Ms. Prosen did not meet the requirements.

# **CONCLUSION OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Ms. Prosen is subject to disciplinary action in accordance with Md. Code Ann. Health Occ. § Health Occ. § 19-311 (6) and COMAR 10.42.06.03.

## **ORDER**

Based on an affirmative vote of a majority of the Board, it is this <b>22nd</b> day of
<u>June</u> , 2023, hereby:
ORDERED that Ms. Prosen license shall be REPRIMANDED; and be it further,
ORDERED that Ms. Prosen will automatically be audit during the next two licensing renewal
Cycles (2023 and 2025).
ORDERED that Ms. Prosen will pay a fine of \$1000
ORDERED that Ms. Prosen complete the outstanding 22.0 category I CEUs which include 2.0
category I CEUs and 20.0 category I or category II including 3.0 Ethics within 120 days from the date of this PCCO submit copies of the CEU certificates to the Board.
ORDERED that this is a formal order of the Maryland board of Social Work Examiners and as
such is a public document pursuant to the Maryland Annotated Code, State Government Articles,
Section 10-617(h).
