








# DDA's Employment First Trajectory

# Customized Employment & the Need to Discover Personal Genius

- Customized Employment (CE) is a newer person- centered employment strategy that builds on all we have learned from supported employment and takes a more Entrepreneurial approach
- It is based upon an individual determination of strengths, needs & interests, of the person with a disability, & is designed to meet the needs of both or using self-employment options



The common goal is a profile describing the person at the present time and to answer the basic question:

"Who is this individual?"

Discovery is a structured Process

Getting to know an individuals Skills, Interests, ideal work culture, tasks, personal attributes



A number of resources now exist to help.


Self-Employment

Maryland Department of Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Maryland Department of Disabilities Administration (DDA), Small Business Development Centers, SCORE groups, Community Action Offices

People with disabilities can maintain much higher \$\$\$ resources/assets with self-employment versus wage employment

# Self-Employment & the Three Legged Stool

- It has to be good fit for the job seeker
- It has to be a viable idea & not just a hobbie
- The needed supports have to be available

# Renaldo's Community Action Team

- 8 people meet every month to support Renaldo
- Paintings selling for \$500 a piece
- Renaldo's art is featured all over the country
- Renaldo has a tremendously supportive family
- One year before the pandemic he made \$27,000

# Funding Small Business start-up


- Social Security Plan for Achieving Self-Support (PASS)
- Medicaid-Waiver and State General Fund
- Maryland Voc Rehab
- One-Stop Centers
- Personal/Earnings/Families/Loans

Self-Employment as a natural choice for People with Disabilities?

- What drives people to selfemployment, disability or not?
- Employment Independence (self employed)
- Natural Skills/talents that are marketable
- Increased Financial Potential
- Creative Freedom



- Feasability Testing: How do we know this business can make it?
- Variables: It fits the person; it fits the Market; It generates a reasonable Wage; It Generates more than it Costs; It Does not allow the Person to look incompetent; It helps someone Achieves a Short-Term Financial or Personal Goal



- How is the business going to operate?
- What work will the Potential Business Owner PBO perform?
- (PBO Person with a disability)
- How will other work get done?
   Who will do it?
- Marketing?
- Sales?
- Accounting/Taxes?
