What are Housing Support Services?

- Housing Support Services include a housing support specialist who will:
 - Support you in creating a housing support plan
 - Support you with applying for rental assistance programs
 - Support you with applying for new apartments or homes
 - Support you in learning how to be a responsible renter
 - Support you in learning how to budget your money and pay bills
 - Advocate with you

How do I access Housing Support Services?

- If you want to live in your own home in a community of your choosing, let your Coordinator of Community Services (CCS) know they can help you find a housing support specialist.

If I live in my own home in the community, can I still access other DDA services?

- Yes, as long as you are DD and waiver eligible you can continue to access other DDA services such as Supported Living, Personal Supports, Meaningful Day Services, Technology, Environmental Modifications, etc.
