The Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) recognizes the critical role that families play in the lives of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD). The role of family is unique, and often key in the support and care provided across the lifespan. Because of that the DDA would like to hear from you.

The DDA continues to partner with the National Core Indicators by participating this year in two (2) family surveys: The Adult Family Survey and the Family Guardian Survey.

The survey is **VOLUNTARY**: This is a survey to improve the quality of services in Maryland.

survey. It is your choice to participate.

The survey is ANONYMOUS: You do not need to put your name on the survey, and your personal

information will not be collected in the survey

The survey is for **QUALITY**: This is an opinion survey to improve the quality of services for

everyone. It is not for planning your personal services. The way you answer the survey questions will not directly affect your services.
