NOVEL H1N1 INFLUENZA CASES

Epidemiology and Disease Control Programs (EDCP) has posted an updated testing algorithm, available on the DHMH website at:

Recommendations are unchanged from the June 22, 2009 testing algorithm, the updated graphic combines recommendations for providers and local health departments into one graphic. Testing is still focused on identifying those most severely affected (hospitalized or deceased) and supporting cluster/outbreak investigations.

This updated guidance will be provided to acute and long term care facilities, and private providers through Med Chi, and the Maryland chapters of AAP, and AAFP.
