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TERMINATION OF PROBATION

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2021, the Maryland State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners (“the Board”) and Respondent Brian J. Belgin, D.P.M. (“the Respondent”) entered into a Consent Order that Reinstated Respondent’s license to practice Podiatry in the state of and placed Respondent’s license under certain terms and conditions of Probation for a period of **TWO (2) YEARS**;


WHEREAS, on or about October 5, 2023, the Respondent submitted a Formal Written Petition to Terminate Probation to the Board for review;

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2023, a quorum of the Board reviewed the Respondent’s Petition and accompanying documents and determined that the Respondent has successfully complied with the probationary terms and conditions imposed by the Consent Order dated October 14, 2021

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Board that the Probationary Terms and Conditions imposed by the Reinstatement and Order of Probation dated October 14, 2021 are hereby **TERMINATED** and are of no further force or effect; and it is further

ORDERED, that this **TERMINATION OF PROBATION ORDER** is a final, public order pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Health Occupations, § 1-607.
