## ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT AND PROBATION

WHEREAS, on or about May 15, 2019, the Maryland State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners (the "Board") accepted the voluntary surrender of the license of Travis Dwyer, D.P.M. License Number 01493, which ended his license to practice podiatric medicine in the State of Maryland;

WHEREAS, Travis Dwyer submitted a petition to reinstate his license to practice podiatric medicine to the Board on or about February 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board having considered the petition to reinstate the license on or about March 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS a quorum of the Board hereby approves Travis Dwyer's petition for the reinstatement of his license, and reinstates the license pursuant to the COMAR 10.40.05.08. It is therefore:

ORDERED, that Travis Dwyer's license to practice podiatry in the State of Maryland under License Number 01493, shall be REINSTATED effective upon the signing of this Order by the Board; and it is further

ORDERED that Travis Dwyer shall be placed on PROBATION for a minimum period of three (3) years, effective from the date of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that Travis Dwyer shall comply with the specific terms and conditions of probation as set forth in the July 1, 2021, Controlled Substance Advisory Committee

Consent Agreement in Case No. 38-09-18 in the State of Delaware ("Consent Agreement") which is incorporated herein by reference; and it is further

ORDERED, that Travis Dwyer may apply for his controlled substance registration with restrictions while following the terms and conditions of the Consent Agreement; and it is further

ORDERED, that Travis Dwyer shall participate in the Delaware Professionals'
Health Monitoring Program (DPHMP) for three (3) years and release to the Board all records including mental health and substance abuse monitoring and treatment records held by the DPHMP. Travis Dwyer is responsible for ensuring the Board receives all records; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that any violation of any of the terms and conditions of probation, including noncompliance with the terms and conditions of the DPHMP will result in the immediate conversion of his probation to suspension for the remainder of the term without further notice or hearing; and it is further

ORDERED, that Travis Dwyer may petition the Board to lift the suspension imposed pursuant to this Order, and the Board may continue the suspension of the license if it finds such action necessary to protect the public, or lift the suspension and impose any additional conditions it deems necessary to protect the public; and it is further

ORDERED, that should the Delaware Board terminate the Respondent's probation at any time prior to the end of the three year period of Probation set forth in this Order, Travis Dwyer may make a written request to the Board to terminate the remaining period of probation; and it is further

ORDERED, that this is a Final Order of the Maryland State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners and as such is a PUBLIC DOCUMENT which shall be posted to the Board's website pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. Art. §4-333(b) (2019 Rep. Vol.) and Health Occupations Article § 1-607 (2019 Rep. Vol.)
