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CRISP provided data summary

- Standard data
 - Panel-based hospitalization outputs (update!)
 - CRISP will not be providing any other standard measure data
- Custom/ad-hoc measures
 - In development
- To enable standard data report, grantees **MUST** submit panels



Standard panel data provided by CRISP

- CRISP is expanding the list of standard hospital measures that we will provide to grantees beyond those available in pre/post
- Because of that change, grantees do NOT need to use Pre/Post report to report the existing standard panel-measures (IP Pre, IP Post, ED Pre, ED Post)
- Standard panel-based measure list is expected to include the following measures at 1 month, 3 month, 6 month, and 12 month analysis levels:
 - Total charges and visits pre and post enrollment for IP
 - Total charges and visits pre and post enrollment for ED
 - Potentially Avoidable Utilization (PAU) charges and visits pre and post enrollment (IP)
- Data will be provided at minimum twice a year (most likely excel format) to respective grantees and CHRC
- Cell sizes less than 11 will be suppressed



Custom/ad-hoc measures

- Grantees requested both panel and geographic based measures
- For panel-based pre/post measures, CRISP also anticipates providing the total charges and visits for the following criteria:
 - Visits for Diabetes
 - Visits for Hypertension
 - Visits for Heart Disease
 - SUD Visits (ED only)
 - Mental Health Visits
 - Specifications for these visits are still under review
- Important limitations:
 - Reporting for inpatient visits for SUD is suppressed under 42 CFR Part 2
 - Non-standard definitions
 - Cell sizes will be suppressed with less than 11
- For geographic measures, CRISP is working on enabling, but may need follow-up specification conversations (JHMI, PG, Baltimore Healthy Start)



Panel Submission

- To enable standard and custom data reporting, grantees must upload ENS Panels + program panels to CRISP every 90 days (ideal is 30)
- Once more grantees have hired data analysts, we will provide a session on uploading panels / programs
