## Includes Increases For:

- $1 \%$ increase for Medicaid Providers (Nursing Homes, Medical Day Care, Personal Assistance, Private Duty Nursing, Community First Choice, and Home and Community Based Options)
- E \& M Physician rate increase to $93 \%$ of Medicare
- $1 \%$ rate increase for MCOs as of January 2018 and a $2.8 \%$ ACA IRS tax that is required
- $2 \%$ increase for Behavioral Health Providers related to Hope Act. BRFA required.
- 15 PINS for a new initiative with the Dept. of Corrections (10 in FY18 and 5 in FY19)
- Targeted Case Management for Children rate increase to $\$ 32$ per unit of service.


## Cost Containment Initiatives

- Eligibility related reductions related to matching enrollee information with surrounding State's data bases and additional verifications of income. (\$35M GF)
- Auto assignment of recipients to an MCO. Recipients would continue to be able to make a change. (\$2M GF)
- Medicaid Deficit Assessment for Hospitals of \$10M
- ABA reduction related to lower utilization than originally anticipated (\$.4MGF)
