# **Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee**

June 27, 2019

## Call to Order and Approval of Minutes

Ms. Vickie Walters, Chair, called to order the meeting of the Maryland Medicaid Advisory Committee (MMAC) at 1:10 p.m. Committee members approved the minutes from the May 23, 2019 meeting as written. Ms. Aileen Tinney attended the meeting for Ms. Carmel Roque and Ms. Lori Doyle attended for Ms. Shannon Hall.

### **Enrollee Committee Seats**

Ms. Kimberly Bennardi, Director, Office of Appointments, informed the Committee that membership on the Committee is outlined in statue and they are appointed by the Secretary of Health. There will be some turnover come July 1<sup>st</sup> as some members are not eligible for reappointment due to term limits.

The Department is actively looking for enrollee members and has done a lot of outreach with limited success. Ms. Roddy added that it has been difficult to recruit enrollees in the past because the meetings are held in the afternoon during the work day. The Department is interested in having an enrollee from the developmental disabilities community or someone who has been or is in a nursing facility or rehab. If members know someone who has or is receiving Medicaid who would like to serve on the MMAC, please contact Ms. Bennardi at 410-767-4049 or Committee staff. The Department has the ability to assist enrollees with transportation and child care costs.

## **HealthChoice Evaluation – Part 2**

Ms. Laura Goodman, Division Chief, Evaluation, Research, and Data Analytics, continued her presentation on the key takeaways of the annual 2019 HealthChoice Evaluation. Due to time constraints during the May MMAC meeting, the HealthChoice Evaluation review continued today starting with Section II, Quality of Care (see attached presentation).

#### Waiver, State Plan and Regulation Changes

Mr. Mark Leeds, Director, Office of Long Term Services and Supports, informed the Committee of the following:

Regulations – all pending regulations are currently in the comment period except for Physician's Services which is getting ready to be published the first week of July. This will update the provider manual and fee schedule for physician's services.

State Plan Amendments (SPA) – there is one SPA that was approved on June 12, 2019, the 1915 (i) for home and community based services, behavioral health.

Waivers – the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA) waiver amendment was approved on June 6, 2019, there is a second amendment that is pending public comment. For

the Home and Community Based Options waiver, the public comment period just ended on June 24, 2019. The Department did receive a couple of comments and is in the process of formulating responses. The Autism waiver renewal has been approved effective July 3, 2019.
