A change of service unit increments for respite care, adult life planning, family consultation, intensive individual support services, therapeutic integration, and intensive therapeutic integration to reflect a 15-minute unit increment.</li> <li>3. A change to the daily minimum for therapeutic integration (regular and intensive) to a half hour unit instead of an hour.</li> <li>4. A change to the educational requirement for Service Coordinators.</li> <li>5. The addition of virtual supports as a service delivery option for individual intensive support services, therapeutic integration (regular and intensive), family consultation and adult life planning.</li> <li>6. The lowering of the age requirement and removal of the lifetime limitation for adult life planning services while receiving residential habilitation.</li> <li>8. Settings Rule	Maryland's Statewide Transition Plan (STP) is due to CMS 4/30/22	The 2014 CMS Settings Rule establishes requirements for home and community-based (HCBS) programs. The purpose of the rule is to maximize the opportunities for HCBS program participants to have access to community living and services in the most integrated setting. All community settings providing HCBS services must be in compliance with the rule by 3/17/23.	The final STP was submitted to CMS on 4/29/22. Since that time, OLTSS has been working with CMS to obtain final approval for the STP. Most recently OLTSS provided a response on 2/13/23 to the round of questions received from CMS on 2/9/23. Additionally, on 12/1/22, OLTSS submitted a corrective action plan (CAP) to CMS requesting additional time beyond 3/17/23. If the CAP is approved, certain non-compliant provider settings will have additional time to come into compliance with the settings rule. The settings team continues to assess provider compliance to prepare for the 3/17/23 deadline. The STP and CAP are pending approval by CMS.
