Network Adequacy Standards

On October 17, 2022, MDH issued a provider transmittal aimed at improving doula network adequacy by allowing the following pending organizations to be considered for single case agreements with MCOs:

- Birth in Color: Community Based Doula Certificate;
- Birth Supporters United*: Community Birth Doula Certificate; and
- Doula Trainings International: Full-Spectrum Doula Certification.



^{*}Note that the current transmittal identifies this organization as "Birthers United". A transmittal to correct this is underway.

Review Process & Timeline

Date or Time Frame	Action Step
10/26/2023 - 11/16/2023	MDH to issue the request for nominations Doula organizations to respond to requests for information
11/17/2023 - 11/22/2023	MDH to review nominations for any missing evaluation information Doula organizations to correct missing information
11/21/2023 - 12/08/2023	MDH to conduct a detailed review of applications
12/11/2023	MDH to issue notifications of certification approval
Upon promulgation of updated regulations	MDH to issue a transmittal with new guidance and add the newly approved organizations to the Professional Services manual



Review Elements


When an organization is nominated, Medicaid reviews the following information:

- Didactic (instructional) components
 - Covers entire perinatal period (pregnancy, birth, and the postpartum period)
 - Includes a test or examination administered following classroom training
- Practicum components
 - Must have observed a minimum of three doula-attended births.
- Certifications Provided:
 - Describes whether the organization offers separate or combined certifications for prenatal, labor and delivery and postpartum periods
 - Provision of certification upon successful completion of program
- Miscellaneous
 - Evidence of health equity focus
 - Attests to current training of doulas
 - Other relevant supportive information
 - Optional reference letter(s)
