For dates of service on or after July 1, 2015, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (the Department), will begin enrolling Physician Assistants (PAs) as Medicaid providers and reimbursing them in accordance with COMAR 10.09.55, and 10.09.36.

The Department will reimburse the Physician Assistants at the lower of their usual and customary charge or the maximum rates in accordance with COMAR 10.09.02.07 (the Physician's fee schedule).
