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Effective May 1, 2017, the Fee-for-Service (FFS) Medicaid Program will require the submission of the individual/rendering NPI provider number on all claims. The Department will continue to require that you submit your group or facility NPI in the pay-to field. It is imperative that each individual/rendering provider within your organization, who is not currently enrolled with the FFS Medicaid Program, enroll no later than March 1, 2017. Failure to enroll as a FFS Medicaid provider will result in the denial of claims.

If you opt to complete the paper application for the rendering provider, please send the signed application and sign provider agreement to the Provider Enrollment address indicated on the application.
