Effective February 1, 2007, Keystone Peer Review Organization, Inc. (KēPRO) will replace the Delmarva Foundation for Medical Care, Inc. (Delmarva) as the Maryland Medical Assistance Program's contractor for utilization control services. KePRO will assume responsibility for performing utilization review activities for the long term care, community service programs and hospitals as follows:

### **Long Term Care and Community Service Programs:**

#### 1. Medical Eligibility Reviews

Level of care determinations for individuals seeking Medicaid coverage of Nursing Facility Services, Medical Day Care, PACE, and waiver services under the Model Waiver, Living at Home Waiver, Waiver for Older Adults and TBI Waiver programs.

#### 2. Nursing Facility Reviews

Continue the Certification Process, Administrative Day Requests, Medical Review for Liens, Patient Assessments, Continued Stay Reviews, Options Counseling and confirm PASRR compliance.

#### 3. Community Services

Medical Day Care Compliance Audits and Medical Day Care Continued Stay Reviews
