RE: Update of Maryland Medicaid's Dental Procedure Codes and Fee Schedule.

The Maryland Medical Assistance Program is proposing to amend Dental Regulations (COMAR 10.09.05) and replace the American Dental Association's (ADA) Current Dental Terminology CDT-4, with the latest update, CDT-2005 effective July 1, 2005. Oral Health Care Providers and Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) must use the CDT-2005's procedure codes when billing for services rendered on or after July 1, 2005 to Medicaid beneficiaries younger than age 21.

Adopting the ADA's latest update, CDT-2005, complies with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability ACT of 1996 (HIPAA). A copy of the Dental Services Fee Schedule incorporating the updated procedure codes found in CDT-2005 is enclosed.
