Billing Medicaid Recipients for Missed Appointments

This transmittal is to inform you that current federal policy prohibits providers from billing Medicaid recipients for any missed appointments. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has recently confirmed this policy to the Department.

Providers may have received verbal or written guidance from the Department or a Medicaid provider, such as a Managed Care Organization, that recipients could be billed for missed appointments, if they are informed of the policy prior to receiving any services. This is no longer the case and any providers who are currently billing for missed appointments must stop immediately. If there is a change in policy at the federal level, the Department will notify providers in another transmittal.
