Fiscal Year 2007 Program Rate Increases

On July 1, 2006, payment rates will increase for certain services under the Home and Community Based Services Waiver for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder. The regulatory requirement for these changes may be found in COMAR 10.09.56 under Regulation .22(C)(3) "Payment Procedures." Payment rates affected by this regulation will be increased by 2.5 percent effective, July 1 of each year. Providers may bill using the new rates for services provided on or after July 1, 2006.

Please note that some waiver services are reimbursed in units of one hour. If less than one hour of service is provided, the time may not be rounded up to one hour. Additionally, provider travel time is not reimbursable by Medicaid.

Only services approved on the waiver participant's Plan of Care or Addendum may be reimbursed. Payment for authorized waiver services covered under this program shall be considered as payment in full, and may not be supplemented by payment from other sources, such as the participant, family, a public program, or private agency.
