Fiscal Year 2004 Program Rate Increases

On July 1, 2003 payment rates will increase for certain services under the Home and Community Based Services Waiver for Children with Autism Spectrum Disorder. The regulatory authority for these changes is found in COMAR 10.09.56 under regulation .22C(3) Payment Procedures. Payment rates affected by this regulation will be increased by 2.5 percent on July 1 of each year. Providers may bill using the new rates for services provided on or after July 1, 2003.
