Changes in School Health Related Services Effective January 1, 2010

The Maryland Medicaid rate methodology is being changed in response to a settlement agreement between the State and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). This agreement established billing policies that require school health-related service providers to bill using the same fee-for-service payment rates as private providers of the same services.

For dates of service beginning January 1, 2010, the new services, codes and rates covered through the school health-related services include:

The Maryland Medical Assistance Program (the Program) has drafted changes to the regulation that defines the basis for billing School Health-Related Services. Specifically, COMAR 10.09.50 is being changed to address the addition of codes for services, the rates for services, and the providers permitted to bill for these services.

The federal agreement also requires that school health-related service providers meet the same credentials as their private sector counterparts. Therefore, school providers will only be permitted to submit claims for professionals who are licensed practitioners of the healing arts, within the scope of his or her practice under Maryland State law. The only exception to this is the Therapeutic Behavior Aide.
