Amendments to Regulation .07 under COMAR 10.09.20, Personal Care Services, have been adopted as proposed. The text of the proposed amendments was included with Personal Care Services Transmittal No. 35, dated October 16, 1998, and was published in the <u>Maryland Register</u> on October 9, 1998 (Vol. 25, Issue 21).

These amendments increase the Level 3 fee for personal care providers and provider agencies from \$25 to \$50 and increase the fee for case monitoring services.
