The amendments to Regulation .06 under COMAR 10.09.12 Disposable Medical Supplies/Durable Medical Equipment have been adopted as proposed. The text of the proposed amendments was included with Medical Supplies and Equipment Transmittal No. 52, dated October 19, 2001, and was published in the <u>Maryland Register</u> on December 28, 2001, (Vol. 28, Issue 26).

These amendments eliminate the preauthorization requirement for disposable incontinence pants for recipients aged three years and older when they do not exceed 240 in any thirty day period, and disposable incontinence under pads for recipients aged three years and older when they do not exceed 135 in any thirty day period.

All other regulatory requirements found in COMAR 10.09.12 remain in force.

The adopted amendments, as printed in the Maryland Register are attached.

This change clarifies that in accordance with the intent of the entire chapter, the Board will not indertake individual approval of courses, but instead will delegate the approval of providers to the CPC Standards Committee. The change does not substantively change the meaning of the regulation and only clarifie, its intent.


