As stated in the HealthChoice regulations (COMAR 10.09.66.01(3)B, "An MCO shall on request accommodate the special access needs of enrollees who do not speak English and require qualified interpreters or are deaf and require qualified interpreters".

This transmittal is to clarify that MCOs who have directed their providers to arrange for these services are ultimately responsible if the service is not being provided. MCOs should verify with their providers that they are in compliance with this requirement.
